Stewardship as a Way of Life:

*"Do you think I have come to give you peace on Earth?
 No, I tell you, but rather division." Luke 12:51*

Many of us like to play it safe, not cause waves with our family and friends, especially when it comes to politics and religion. We don't want to cause any turmoil. However, many times this is at the expense of the truth. The truth being Jesus Christ. Too many people are misguided because they rely on their own limited human ability to reason and are not allowing faith in God to guide them. Form your conscience; take a stance for life, marriage, and religious liberty.



Dear parishioners of Sacred Heart, St Lawrence, Holy Cross and St Henry's :

Our lives are filled with many challenges, and likewise the Church has faced 'too' many challenges in the last twenty centuries. The Church has overcome all of them, which proves what the Lord said: *"I will be with you until the end of times"*

With this letter, I want to inform you of a big challenge that we have to face in our Diocese and in our ACC (Area Catholic Community). It is a serious challenge but if we work together in faith, we'll be able to deal with these challenges successfully and make it through!

You've probably heard about the declining number of priests in our Diocese. Presently, we only have 57 active priests to take care of the 131 parishes in the 16 counties that make up the Diocese of St Cloud. That's the reason most of us priests are taking care of multiple parishes.

Today, we have less than half of the priests that we had fifty years ago and the amount of pastoral work has increased. This is the reason Bishop Neary has created the plan called "All Things New" to address in a proactive way the changes we need to make in the near future. For example, the cutting the number of Masses and unfortunately, the possible closing of some parishes.

One change that we will make next year is to move from 8 Masses to 6 Masses on weekends. Bishop Neary has asked that no priest is to offer more than 3 Masses on the weekends. Experience and medical science have taught us that the health of parish priests gets compromised when they consistently say more than 3 Masses on weekends. With this in mind, starting next year, we will follow the Bishop's directive in our ACC and will have 6 Masses instead of 8 every weekend.

I have created a Committee made up with representatives from each of our four parishes. Together, we will need to develop a plan for our ACC and this plan will be

submitted to the Bishop's office before the end of the year. The Diocese has requested a conservative plan in which we will present our 6 Masses schedule.

However, a few days ago, they told us to begin to work on an aggressive plan. What will we do in case we only had one priest? This possibility is not what we want to hear but it could possibly happen in the future. Currently, the Diocese doesn't have any extra priests in case something happens to one of us. This plan scares us all but we need to be ready for the worst case scenario and be proactive.

As the plan is being developed, we will have four listening sessions within the next month, one in each parish. We will have a presentation and discuss possibilities for our ACC. Every parishioner is welcomed to come to these sessions. I hope that we can be realistic in our proposals. We want to seek alternatives, although we know that not all alternatives will make everybody happy.

In all of this, we need to remember that the problem is not you, nor me, nor the parish. It is not the Bishop or any Diocesan staff member. The problem is that we simply do not have the number of priests we would like to have serving the people of God in our many parishes. That is the problem and the question is, how we are going to make it work (?)
