#### Stewardship as a Way of Life:

"They all ate and were satisfied. And when the leftover fragments were picked up, they filled twelve wicker baskets." (Luke 9:17)

The story of the Loaves and Fishes shows us that when you share what you have, even if it doesn't seem like that much, miracles can happen! Do not think that your gift is too small or insignificant! Each of us has a role in God's plan; you just need to place your trust in the Lord. Nothing is impossible with God. You just may be the answer to someone else's prayer.



#### Feast of Corpus Christi

A special greeting to all of you who come to Mass and to all our Adorers. I join your prayers for those who do not come to Mass and miss receiving the amazing graces that The Lord has for them.

The Feast of Corpus Christi, originated in the 13<sup>th</sup> century, is also known as the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. The Church honors Jesus Christ, Really, Truly, and Substantially Present under the appearances of bread and wine. This Presence happens through the change which the Church calls transubstantiation ("change of substance") when at the Consecration of the Mass, the priest says the words which Christ Himself pronounced over bread and wine, "This is My Body," "This is the chalice of My Blood," "Do this in memory of Me."

The Holy Mass is the central mystery of our Faith. We see the Institution of the Eucharist in all four gospels—at the Last Supper in Matthew, Mark, and Luke, and in the sixth chapter of the Gospel according to John. In verse 56 of John 6, Jesus says "Anyone who does eat My flesh and drink My blood has eternal life, and I shall raise that person up on the last day" There is a big connection between our reception of the Eucharist and eternal life. Jesus promises Heaven to those who receive Him in the Eucharist in a worthy manner!

Vatican II speaks about this teaching beautifully: "At the Last Supper, on the night He was betrayed, our Savior instituted the Eucharistic sacrifice of His Body and Blood. This He did in order to perpetuate the sacrifice of the Cross throughout the ages until He should come again, and so entrust to His beloved Spouse, the Church, a memorial of His death and resurrection: a sacrament of love, a sign of unity, a bond of charity, a paschal banquet in which Christ is consumed, the mind is filled with grace, and a pledge of future glory is given to us."

#### Guidelines for the Reception of Holy Communion

As Catholics, we fully participate in the celebration of the Eucharist when we receive Holy Communion. We are encouraged to receive Communion devoutly and frequently. In order to be properly disposed to receive Communion, participants should not be conscious of grave sin and normally should have fasted for one hour. A person who is conscious of grave sin is not to receive the Body and Blood of Christ without prior sacramental confession. A frequent reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation is encouraged for all.

Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, Vatican Council II, 47.

Non-Catholics are always welcome to the Mass. We pray that our common baptism and the action of the Holy Spirit will draw us closer to one another and begin to dispel the sad divisions which separate us. We pray that these will lessen and finally disappear, in keeping with Christ's prayer for us "that they may all be one" (Jn 17:21).

Because Catholics believe that the celebration of the Eucharist is a sign of the reality of the oneness of faith, life, and worship, members of those churches with whom we are not yet fully united are ordinarily not admitted to Holy Communion. It is our obligation to talk to our Protestant friends and/or relatives before they come to Church with us. While we cannot admit them to Holy Communion, we ask them to offer their prayers for the peace and the unity of the human family. If someone you know has the desire to become Catholic, please put them in contact with the me, and I will answer any questions concerning the preparation process.

#### Why Is the Precious Blood Not Distributed at Every Mass?

We must remember that "the whole and entire Christ and the true sacrament are received under either species." A person receives the fullness of grace of the sacrament whether just receiving the Sacred Host alone, or the Precious Blood alone, or both together. Most parishes in the world offer both the Body and the Blood of the Lord at Solemnities and special celebrations only.

St John Vianney: There is nothing so great as the Eucharist. If God had something more precious, He would have given it to us. Blessed Carlo Acutis: The Eucharist is my highway to Heaven!
