In a letter to the pastors and ACC chairs dated March 2020, Bishop Kettler asked all ACCs to create a joint pastoral council in an effort to set our ACCs up for success. He was asking each ACC planning council to create an ACC joint pastoral council.

In response to Bishop Kettler's request and an effort to unify and strengthen the formation of our Northern Cross Area Catholic Community (NCACC), the local Parish Pastoral Councils of Holy Cross, Butler; St. Henry, Perham; St. Lawrence, Rush Lake; and Sacred Heart, Dent will be dissolved as of April 1, 2022. The Northern Cross ACC Pastoral Council includes three members representing each of the four NCACC parishes to ensure that each of the member parishes will have a voice in future planning and decision-making.
