

Removal of flowers shall be no later than 14 days after Memorial Day. If not removed by the giver, maintenance personnel shall remove and dispose of them. This ruling will not apply to flowers in containers that are part of the headstone. Removal of such will be entirely up to the giver.

The Feast of the Ascension of the Lord is one of the earliest Christian festivals. On the 40th day He took them to the Mount of Olives, where they watched as He ascended to heaven. Ascension is officially celebrated on the 40th day of Easter. It occurs ten days before Pentecost and always falls on a Thursday. However, in many dioceses of the United States, it is celebrated on the following Sunday.

The following items are things that the MNSAA Onsite Team found that didn't meet the standards of the Minnesota Non-Public School Accrediting Association. These items will be worked on, fixed, attended to, so that we continue to meet their standards. Some items will be added to our long-range strategic plan, some items will be fixed immediately, and others will be worked on over the summer to be instituted by the beginning of the 2023-2024 school year. Overall, the onsite team was very pleased with our school, and commended us on meeting and exceeding many of the MNSAA standards.

- ⇒ The team recommends creating a written policy for the review of the mission statement.
- ⇒ The team recommends that assessment results be shared with all stakeholders, not just staff and families, and that the results be used to more effectively guide curriculum decisions.
- ⇒ The team recommends that we create a written procedure for identifying students with academic needs.
- ⇒ The team recommends that we create a tardiness policy.
- ⇒ The team recommends that we update the crisis management plan to reflect the new building, and that we consider changing the pick-up procedure at the end of the day.
- ⇒ The team recommends that we consider updating development strategies for the future.
- ⇒ The team recommends that we modify our strategic plan to include more measurable actions steps and to share that plan in a better way with our stakeholders. The team also recommends that the action steps be equally distributed to include more stakeholders in the process.




