



Hey everyone,

If you've gone to confession within the last week and a half, you've probably noticed a couple changes in the prayer of absolution. Back in 2021, the United States bishops approved a new translation for the prayer, and it was officially approved by the Holy See in April of 2022. As of Ash Wednesday 2023, the new version can now be prayed by the priest in confession. While the essential words of the formula of absolution have *not* been changed, the Holy See has confirmed two minor modifications to the first part of the prayer:

God, the Father of mercies, through the Death and Resurrection of his Son has reconciled the world to himself and sent the Holy Spirit among us for the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church may God give you pardon and peace. AND I ABSOLVE YOU FROM YOUR SINS, IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER, AND OF THE SON, AND OF THE HOLY SPIRIT. (R. Amen.)	God, the Father of mercies, through the Death and Resurrection of his Son has reconciled the world to himself and poured out the Holy Spirit for the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church may God grant you pardon and peace. AND I ABSOLVE YOU FROM YOUR SINS, IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER, AND OF THE SON, AND OF THE HOLY SPIRIT. (R. Amen.)

Personally, I'm a big fan of the changes, especially going from "sent" to "poured out." It's a beautiful reminder that God is not stingy with His grace and mercy, but that God the Holy Spirit has been poured out upon us like an immense waterfall of mercy! When you receive absolution in the Sacrament of Confession, think of yourself as being at the bottom of Niagara Falls... this is the mercy that God gives us when we receive the gift of absolution. His mercy is absolutely unfathomable!

I could probably end it here, but since I have some more space in this letter, I thought it might be fun to offer some answers to frequently asked questions about the Sacrament of Reconciliation. So here we go:

How often should I go to confession?

The Church asks us to confess our sins "at least once a year." It's one of the five precepts of the Church, and it's something the Church asks of us because she knows we need it. With that said, "at least once a year" is the bare minimum. Personally, I'd recommend going more often, even once a month. Frequent reception of this sacrament will change your life.

Confession is so embarrassing. How do I overcome my anxiety and fear?

In the words of a brother priest, feeling ashamed of one's sins "is already the first healthy sign of a conscience that has not grown numb or blind to evil." Pray for the grace to be brave, and don't allow this shame to keep you from the sacrament of mercy. Also, I want to remind you that there

is no obligation to go to confession face-to-face. The screen is always an option, and no priest will ever look down on you for it.

Do you recognize people even if they confess behind the screen?

The screen definitely helps with anonymity, but I'll be honest, there are times when a person's voice is recognizable. But that reminds me of a story. Someone once asked a priest if he looked differently at someone after he heard their confession. He said, "Yes. I look at them with so much more respect that they would be willing to sacrifice their reputation for their relationship with God." As a priest, I'm just so happy that you're there.

4. What's it like to hear confessions as a priest?

Hearing confessions is one of my favorite parts of the priesthood. Fr. Mike Schmitz said it well, "I see the costly mercy of God in action. I get to regularly come face-to-face with the overwhelming, life-transforming, power of God's love. I get to see God's love up close." Everytime I get to hear confessions, I get to see the miracle of God's mercy.

I had a bad experience the last time I went. What if I don't feel comfortable going back?

First of all, I'm sorry to hear you had a bad experience. Sometimes priests can be distracted, tired, unprepared, and even straight-up impatient. While the Church asks us to go to confession, there's no obligation to go to the same priest each time. Don't let a bad experience keep you from the confessional... Jesus is waiting for you there.

6. What if I forget to confess a sin from my past?

If you do your best to confess all of your sins, and if you do not intentionally withhold anything, you are absolved of ALL YOUR SINS when you receive absolution, including anything you might have forgotten. Be at peace.

7. What if I don't remember how to go to confession?

Just ask the priest... he will help you out.

Please know of my prayers for you during this Lenten season. It is my prayer that you make confession a regular part of your spiritual life. If you ever have any questions or want to chat further, I'm always available.
