Mother's Day celebration will be on May 9th; Faith Formation students meet in the church hall before Mass and enter as a group. Ice cream sundaes will be served after Mass.

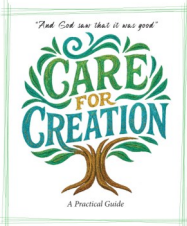

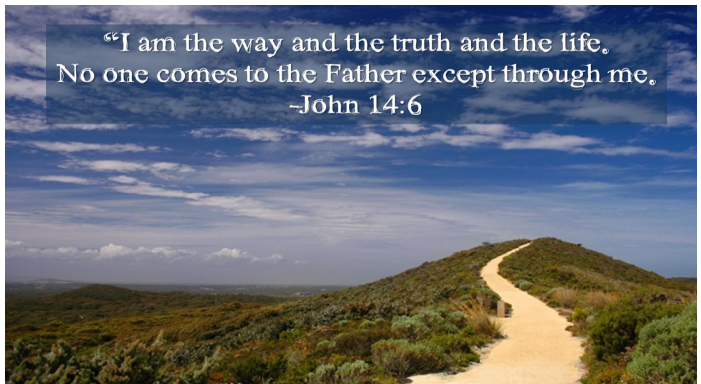
