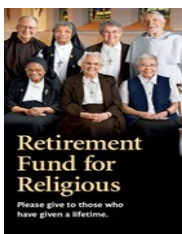

In honor of Jesus' birthday St. Lawrence Faith Formation students are collecting items to create Birthday Boxes for our local food shelves.

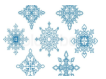

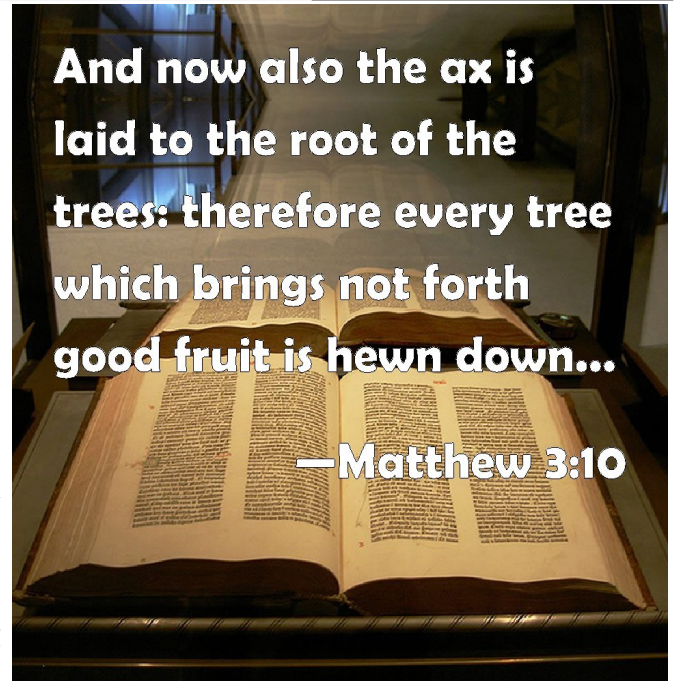
"Therefore, every tree that does not bear good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire."
