December 7: A second collection will be taken at the 10:30AM Mass to help purchase additional supplies. See the bulletin board for more information.

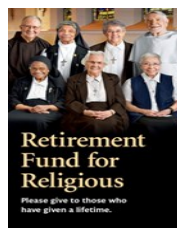

Advent Greetings!

I hope your Advent preparation is going well and that your Christmas time may be one of special blessings. As we approach the end of the year, I would like to share with you that the number of Christmas Masses will be lower than previous years. In the past, we used the help of retired priests which allowed us to have a few extra Christmas Masses. However, this year is different. Fr Arlie was supposed to help us with two or three Masses, but he was recently asked by the Bishop to assist the five parish cluster that Fr Joe Herzing serves in Todd County. May The Lord bless Fr Joe at this time of trial! Our prayers are with him! May the Lord also bless Fr Arlie who is always willing to help despite his retirement.

After losing Fr Arlie's help I contacted 11 priests and they are all booked and helping in different parishes of the Diocese. In view of all this, six Masses will be offered in our four parish ACC, four on Christmas Eve and two on Christmas Day. The words of Bishop Patrick come to mind when he said that we have no priest sitting on the bench; the shortage of priest is real and we do what we humanly can do. This is the reason you will see the reduction in the number of Christmas Masses. Please, keep praying for more vocations to the priesthood and for all priests to grow in holiness and stay healthy.

It is a wonderful journey, and I really enjoy being here to serve all of you in my limited capacity. I'm happy to be in these faith-filled communities where I've met so many wonderful people. Let's keep supporting one another in faith, hope and charity!

On a personal note, I am happy to have my siblings with me. They came to America last year and they will probably have to leave the country in 2026. My siblings, even though they are here legally and working full-time, are at risk of losing the opportunity of being here. That's something we never thought would happen, but life is full of challenges, and we just need to trust that the Lord will indeed hear the cry of the poor and open a new path where there seems to be no path. To me, every day with them is a blessing and whatever happens in 2026 we know that our faith will sustain us. On the other hand, I hope that the Lord will grant me the

opportunity to see my parents next year. They're in Venezuela, and the last time I saw them was in 2018. A lot of things have happened since then, the pandemic, my Venezuelan passport expired, the situation in Venezuela has worsen etc. I realize now that it is time to visit them because it has been a long time. I hope in the Lord that I can see my folks next year!

Back to the situation in our Diocese, the All Things New process is underway and changes will be made in 2026. We've been asked to design a conservative plan and an aggressive plan for our Northern Cross ACC. The conservative plan contemplates having two priests, which is what we have at the present time. Each priest will say three Masses on the weekends as Canon Law prescribes. The aggressive plan is the tough one because it contemplates the option of having only one priest. He will say three Masses for the four parishes and of course we know that three Masses is not enough.

The Diocese is trying to plan according to the declining number of priests and be prepared to face the future by doing so. Again, we will see changes in some parishes from the Diocese next July and such changes may affect our routine and demand some adjustment. In all of this, the most important goal is to have access to the Eucharist within reasonable driving distances. The Eucharist is the center and the summit of our faith, and the Lord is still with us, even as the boat is being tossed by strong winds. He is with us! This is His Church! We will keep sailing forward with Him until we reach the other side of the Kingdom!

To conclude, I give thanks to God for all of you committed Catholic brothers and sisters, for the growing number of students in our school, for the faithful adorers in our Adoration Chapel, for the youth seeking Christ, for those families that have Christ at the center of their lives, for those suffering illness with grace, and for the good I see in so many people. The light will never be conquered by darkness and that's what I celebrate this Christmas. That Light came into the world. Our Light is Jesus!
