



## FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN ONLY IN PRESCHOOL

As a family with only preschool children for your “school aged” children. You have the option of paying \$10.00 for the year to receive At Home family lessons and materials. These lessons are geared toward young learners and provide a lot of background information for parents as well. If you are interested in this option, please register your preschool child, and select the option that you would like preschool take home lessons.

There are no classes at the Church for Preschool age children, all learning will take place at home.

Parents of Preschool Children are strongly encouraged to come to the Family Faith Formation days to build your own knowledge of the Catholic Faith and to meet other parents who have children in the program. You can choose which day each month works for you. We will provide free childcare for any children that you have that would need care.

The Family Faith Formation Days will be an hour long for you and will teach you about different forms of prayer (Liturgy of the Hours, the Rosary, Litanies, novenas, Lection Divina etc.

Each month we will also have a talk on a specific Catholic topic. You can view the dates and topics below. It is not required for you to come this year but is strongly encouraged!

**Sundays:** Each Sunday, there will be a free brunch served (pending COVID) from 11am-12pm. Then any children who need care will go to the school gym (before 12:00pm) and parents will go up to the Church to learn about prayer and hear the talk. You will be free to go get your children at 1:00pm and go home.

**Wednesdays:** Each Wednesday, there will be a free supper served (pending COVID) from 5:15pm-6:00pm. Any children needing care will go to the school gym before 6:00pm and parents will go up to the Church to learn about prayer. Wednesdays will end with Mass at 7:00pm that you are welcome to come to.
