Stewardship as a Way of Life: "...because I came down from heaven not to do my own will but the will of the one who sent me....'" John 6:38

When praying the "Our Father", say the words slowly so you truly recognize what you are saying. Every day when praying this prayer, we repeat what Jesus said in the scripture passage – "thy kingdom come, thy will be done." Even though we say these words, do our actions reflect those words?
